PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025

This Order is made by Leicestershire County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called "the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

Charnwood Borough Council has been consulted and has consented to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over the land situated off Main Street, Ratcliffe and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 30 days from the date of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 1 where immediately before the date on which the public right of way referred to therein is diverted in pursuance of this Order, there is apparatus on, under or over the right of way belonging to statutory undertakers, for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

3. There shall at the end of 30 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land off Main Street, Ratcliffe on the Wreake described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 1 these provisions for the extinguishment of the public right of way shall not come into force until the Leicestershire County Council acting by its proper officer shall have certified that the agreed works have been carried out to its satisfaction in accordance with Section 119(3) of the 1980 Act.
5. This Order may be cited as the "Leicestershire County Council (Public Footpath 169 (Part) off Main Street, Ratcliffe on the Wreake) Public Path Diversion Order 2025."

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING EXISITING PATH OR WAY

That part of Footpath I69 in the Parish of Ratcliffe on the Wreake and the Borough of Charnwood, shown as a bold continuous line on Plan No. 2670, which extends from point "A" on the Plan, situated at a junction with Main Street, Ratcliffe on the Wreake and at grid reference 46297 31449, in a generally north westerly direction over the driveway and through the garage of number 21 Main Street and continuing over the field to the rear of the property for a total distance of approximately 60 meters to point "B" on the plan, situated in the field to the rear of Nos.21 and 27 Main Street, at grid reference 46292 31453.

The route of Footpath I69 to be diverted has no recorded width.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A Footpath I69, in the Parish of Ratcliffe on the Wreake and the Borough of Charnwood, shown as a bold broken line on Plan No. 2670, will extend from point "C" on the Plan, situated at a junction with Main Street, Ratcliffe on the Wreake and at grid reference 46297 31450, in a generally north westerly then west north-westerly direction up a short flight of steps, along a passageway and through the field to the rear of Nos. 21 and 27 Main Street for a total distance of approximately 60 metres to re-join the original line of the Footpath at point "B" on the Plan, previously described.

The new alternative Footpath I69 will have a width of 1.8m between Main Street and Ratcliffe on the Wreake and grid reference 46292 31453

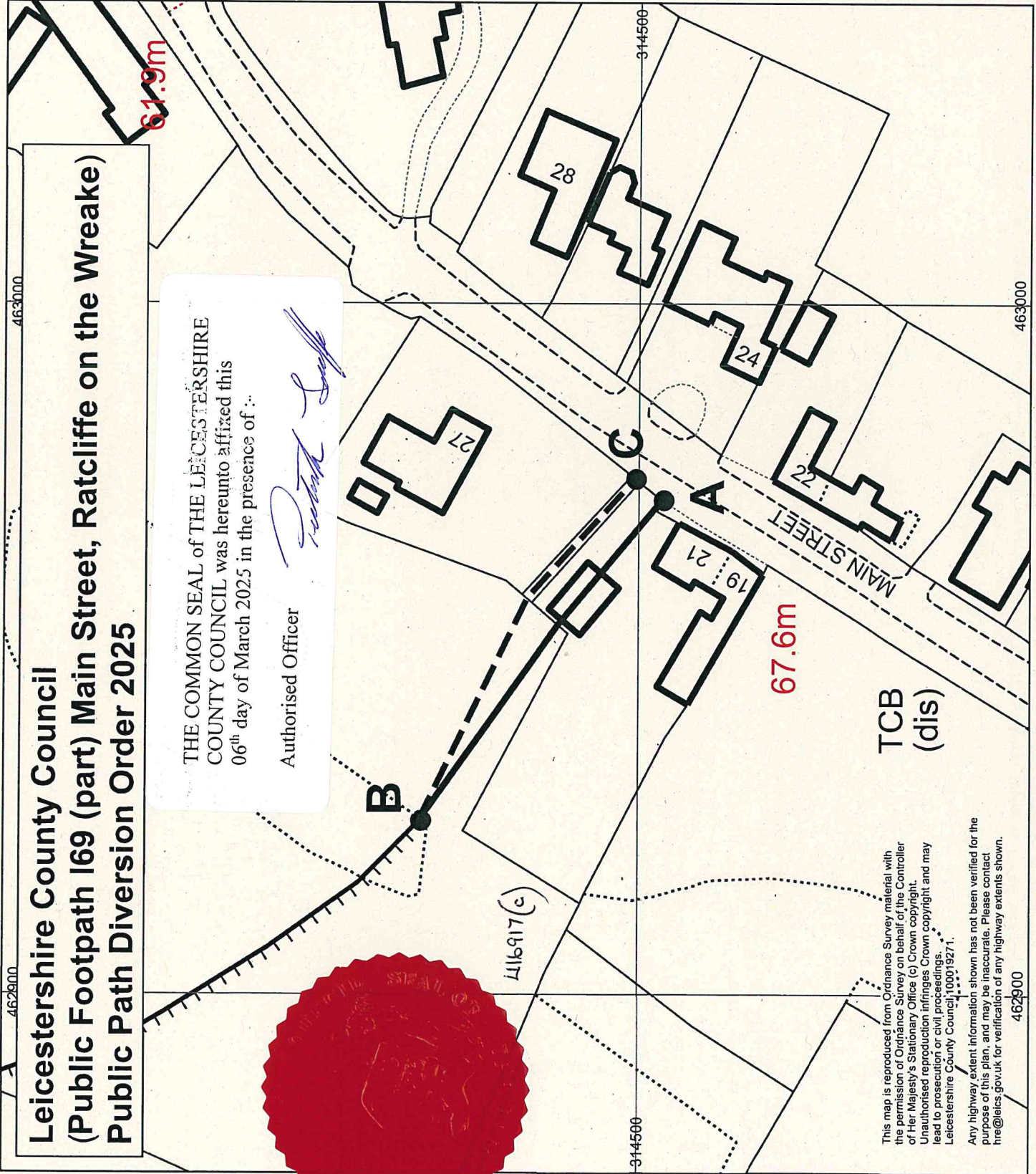

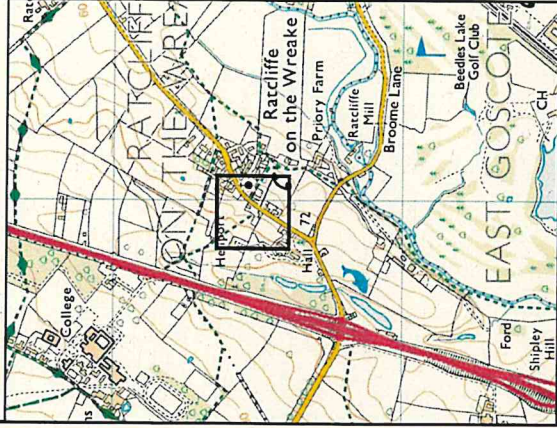
